He composed for the KRONOS QUARTET, ART ENSEMBLE OF CHICAGO, GERMAN CHAMBER PHILHARMONICS, BALANESCU QUARTET and the ALIAGE QUARTET, ...

Between 1980 and 1990 he toured with his quartet OPEN ART BAND in Europe and was invited to the Indian Jazz-Yatra-Festival in Bombay, Delhi, Bangalore and Goa.



His music, dance and theatre performances, as well as his 'immersive environment' installations, are shown at major festivals in all parts of the world.

In 2005 and 2008 he taught as an adjunct professor for composition at the Webster University Vienna.

Since 2006 he is visiting professor at the University IUAV of Venice, Italy, teaching directing and new media.
